#### **Professional Development**

#### STEAM and Al Praxis Session



We continuously develop STEAM praxis in the classroom to encourage creativity, enhance technological literacy, develop teamwork skills, and prepare students for future careers. We are using Al in the teaching-learning process carefully from the perspective of the emerging use of Artificial Intelligence.

In this regard, we conducted a training session on STEAM and AI in collaboration with Kathmandu University.

#### **Design Thinking**



In-House Teachers Professional Development session on 'Design Thinking Pedagogy' was conducted by Nikendra Gurung, Middle School In-charge, for the teachers of grades IV and V. This pedagogical approach stresses the importance of empathy, collaboration and experimentation to develop innovative solutions that addresses real-world problems. This pedagogy empowers individuals to think creatively, challenge assumptions and generate practical solutions that meet the needs of the end-users.

#### **Effective Lesson Planning**



An In-House teacher development workshop was conducted on 'Effective Lesson Planning' for Middle School teachers by the Block In-charge Mr. Nikendra Gurung. The session helped the teachers to delve into strategies and techniques to design and deliver impactful lessons that engage students and promote effective learning. The teachers explored the 3CR module of lesson planning format, cognitive domain of Bloom's Taxonomy and setting clear learning objectives using SMART approach.

#### **SEL Session for Teachers**



A session on 'Spread Positivity, Positive Discipline: Balancing Between Disciplining and Maintaining Strong Connection' was conducted by the facilitators from Sambhavya Foundation for the teachers of grades IV and V. The session focused on how the teachers should help in addressing the socio-emotional needs of the students in a positive manner, incorporating socio-emotional learning (SEL) and creating a supportive classroom environment. The session also provided the teachers with strategies for addressing the behavioral issues of students.

#### STEAM in Classroom



As a part of our institutional collaborative effort with Karkhana, two of our Science teachers from grades VI and VII, attended the orientation session organized by Karkhana in King's College. The session highlighted the significance of incorporating STEAM approach in the classroom. It highlighted the ways through which the Karkhana-designed toolkit would help educators to support the learners in gaining conceptual clarity of the contents mentioned in the national curriculum for Science.
