PD Training/Workshops for Teachers

- Pedagogy for Nepali language teachers, led by Dr DP Bhattarai and Mr Dilliram Dhungel, Language Experts, and
- Teaching Social Studies Effectively, led by Mr. Yubraj Gautam, an Expert in Social Studies.

The teachers found the sessions to be highly enriching and informative. They gained valuable insights and practical strategies that they can apply in their classrooms to enhance the learning experience of their students.

Understanding the SEL Program



Shambavya Foundation, our collaborative partner for Psycho-social counseling conducted an orientation session for our new Middle School teachers, focusing on our school's SEL program. This session provided an understanding of the goals of program which included promoting emotional well-being, enhancing social skills, and supporting academic success through emotional intelligence and mindfulness practices. Field Visits

Central Zoo



The students of Grade I went for a visit to the zoo with an objective of observing wild animals, their habitat, their babies and their food habits. It indeed was an enriching experience for them as they don't observe wild animals so closely often.

Neighbourhood Visit





The students of Grade II visited the school neighborhood to meet the neighbors and study about their different occupations. This visit was based on the theme 'My Family and I'.

ICIMOD





Grade X students visited ICIMOD to learn about mountain ecosystem, climate change, and sustainable development in the Himalayas. Interactive exhibits and discussions highlighted the importance of environmental conservation and research in addressing environmental challenges. This experience inspired students to advocate for global environmental stewardship.

Tiger Lily Petting Farm



Our little Kindergarteners went on a field trip to 'Tiger Lily Petting Farm' based on the theme 'Domestic Animals'. During the trip, they observed and learnt about different domestic animals and their habitats, their food, and their young ones. Spending time with animals and feeding them added much joy to this trip of the tiny toddlers. They were also introduced to some traditional farming and household tools and were briefed about their importance in our daily life.

Food Technology and Quality Control Department





Grade X A had an insightful visit to the Department of Food Technology and Quality Control in Babarmahal, Kathmandu. They observed laboratory analysis of various food products, ensuring that the quality standards were met. The students witnessed food and feed analysis for contaminants and additives, which is crucial for consumer safety. Additionally, they learned about the development, updating, and publication of food composition tables, vital for nutritional information. The visit also provided insights into the licensing process for the food industry and the functioning of laboratory devices.

Bishnumati River



The students of Grade III were taken to the banks of Bishnumati River with an objective of teaching them about the causes of water pollution, different contaminants (eg. dirt, leaves, litter, detergents, chemicals, pesticides, human waste, etc) and ways to control water pollution.

Lok Baja Sangrahalaya





The eager learners of Grade X had a learning expedition to the Nepali Folk Musical Instrument Museum in Tripureshwor. The visit integrated the Social Studies topic 'Hamro Lok Baja'. On the trip, the learners got detailed information about different musical instruments found in various parts of Nepal. They learnt the importance of the conservation of these instruments. Mr. Ram P. Kandel, the Founder Director of the Museum, helped the learners in satisfying their curiosity.

Visit to the Zoo





The little Kindergartners were taken to the Central Zoo for an exploration learning about water animals, wild animals, and domestic animals. The zoo offered an opportunity to observe different animals, their young ones, their habitats, and their food habits. This trip helped them to differentiate between water, wild, and domestic animals.

Godawari Botanical Garden





Our Grade VII learners embarked on an enriching field trip to the Godawari Botanical Garden, immersing themselves in the beauty and diversity of nature. This educational excursion provided a hands-on learning experience, allowing students to explore various plant species, understand their ecological significance, and appreciate the importance of conservation. Ward No. 6 Office

Grande International Hospital





Grade X students went to the Grande International Hospital to learn about blood typing. During the visit, the hospital staff demonstrated the blood typing process and explained the importance of antigen-antibody reactions and the ABO & Rh systems. This hands-on experience enhanced the students' understanding of the significance of blood groups in medical science.

Family Visit



The young learners of Grade I visited a joint family to meet the objective of their learning based on the theme 'My Family & I'. They learnt the concept of joint family through interaction with grandparents and the other members of the family.

Chhauni and Military Museum





Our Grade VI students enjoyed a fascinating field trip to the Chhauni Museum and the Military Museum, diving into the rich history and heritage of our nation. This educational excursion offered students a unique glimpse into the past, showcasing a collection of historical artefacts, military exhibits, and cultural treasures. Changu Narayan & Bhaktapur Durbar Square
